### Miami Beach Convention Center: COVID-19 Alternative Care Facility Conversion



As of April 21, 2020, The Miami Beach Convention Center has been transformed into a temporary hospital. In just under two weeks, The Army Corp of Engineers lead the way of converting this facility into a 450-bed field hospital to assist in the recovery of Covid-19 patients.

Thermal Concepts received a PO to upgrade the air filtration from standard MERV 8 and MERV 10 filters to hospital-grade MERV 13 pre-filters and MERV 16 final filters. The PO was placed with WACO, and expedited filter production began in York, SC, and Joliet, Illinois.

The Government request ordered on April 6th was to expedite the 10-day manufacturing of all 1200 filters, direct shipped to the facility, and installed in all (40) AHU's servicing the A, B, C & D Halls of the Convention Center... all to be completed by the April 21st deadline and opening of the temporary hospital. This allowed Thermal Concepts only 4-5 days to get the job done.

As always, Team Thermal came together and got the job done. another job well done all around, starting with the Service Dispatch Department managing a critical schedule. Followed by the hard work and dedication of the project field leader Greg Kaouk putting together a select team of Service Technicians: Luis Guzman, Carlos Calderon, Abe Zakhra, Daril Gomez & Osnay Rodriguez.
